April responded that two of the brochures included were not digital and that an OA coin was also sent in the packet. April said the cost of postage was \$1.20 within the US and \$2.71 abroad.

Creating a fund to send representative(s) to annual and other events and allocate monthly funds to that fund. Karen R requested this item to be held over to May 2023 GC meeting.

9. New Business Proposed Motions:

Devi said that she would like to know how to create this type of slide.
